The scholarship will be granted without consideration of financial need and is renewable for a maximum of eight semesters or until graduation in an undergraduate program, whichever comes first.

Box 1059, Kilmarnock, VA 22482. The completed application may be hand delivered or mailed, but it must be received in the business office by the end of the business day, 4:00 pm, on March 1st.

The following additional documents must accompany your application:

- 1. A full transcript of your high school record including first semester senior year. Second semester senior year grades must be forwarded to the committee at the end of the school year before funds can be forwarded to the post-secondary school.
- 2. Two letters of reference from teachers, employers, or other non- family members who know you.
- 3. A personal essay of 250-500 words. See page 3.
- 4. **Optional:** You may submit a performance tape of CD, slides (35 mm only), or usb of art work, photography, etc. If you choose to do so, please be sure to label the material with your name and address and include a self-addressed mailing folder so that the material can be returned to you.
- 5. Finalists for the McCullough Scholarship must meet with the Grace Church Scholarship Committee for a personal interview to be scheduled by the committee between March 1st and April 1st.
- 6. The McCullough Scholarship will be awarded by May 1 contingent on satisfactory final grades being forwarded to the committee at the end of the school year.
- 7. Scholarship payments will be sent to the institution of your choice. <u>Please provide the address</u> of the finance office of the college, university or technical school you will be attending.
